

SECTION 4. DUES and TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Membership dues shall be at such a rate or rates, schedules or formula as may, from time to time, be prescribed by the board of directors, payable annually in advance.

Dues will run for one year from January 1st through December 31st.

Members who do not pay their annual membership dues each new calendar year, will automatically be dropped from the membership roster and not allowed to participate in any Club activities. Members who wish to reinstate themselves after an allowable time for paying dues may submit a new application to the Secretary/Treasurer and pay the full current year dues.

New members joining after September 1st in the calendar year will:

- a) Pay a full year dues**
- b) The money will also be applied to the next calendar year dues (paid for in full).**

ARTICLE III FISCAL YEAR AND MEETINGS

SECTION 1. FISCAL YEAR

The fiscal year shall close on December 31st of each year.

SECTION 2. MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS

Meetings, social events or other activities will be held at the discretion of the officers and the board of directors. Whenever feedback from the membership is needed on important matters that need a prompt response, you will be contacted by the use of e-mail and/or phone. The monthly newsletter (seasonal) will be sent via e-mail to those members who have access to it. All other members will receive it by regular mail.

ARTICLE IV OFFICERS AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS

SECTION 1. OFFICERS

At the first business meeting of the year, the membership shall elect and install the officers for a one-year term as follows: President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. The job of Secretary and Treasurer can be a combined office. Nominations for these offices will also be accepted from the floor.

The President shall appoint committees and committee chairmen at his or her discretion. In the event the President cannot complete the term of office or is not in attendance at a regular or called meeting, the Vice-President shall serve in that capacity.
